Purpose:

- The Education Committee is charged with strategically leading the Society in creating comprehensive and innovative educational initiatives for Society members, learners and urologists worldwide.

Committee

Members:

- The Education Committee will be co-chaired by the Director of Education and Association Director of Education. The committee will consist of 6 representatives from all specialty areas of Endourology. The Secretary General and Treasurer will serve as ex-officio members of the committee.

**Objective/
Responsibilities:**

- Organize WCET educational courses. The committee is responsible for developing courses for each year’s meeting and providing speaker suggestions.
- Provide speaker suggestions and educational programming for special requests made by international endourology societies.
- Organize online educational activities including masterclass series and podcast series.
- The Chair is responsible for providing a report to the Board of Directors biannually (or when needed).
- The Secretary General and Treasurer will serve as ex-officio members of the committee.
- The Committee Chairs are part of the Endourology Society AUA Program Planning Committee.
